Hello,

California Senate Bill (SB) 1100 requires employers to carefully evaluate whether a driver's license is truly necessary for the performance of the job. This requires changes to how we include driver's license requirements in job postings and when making employment decisions.

#### Changes to Job Builder on 4/15/2025:

On 4/15/2025, Job Builder will be updated with a required driver's license section. You will need to respond to the question/s in the new section when submitting a job description. Specific questions attached.



## If driving is an essential function of the job:

- Outline the specific job duties that necessitate a valid driver's license in the key responsibilities section of the job description
- · Identify what types of vehicles will be used
- Indicate legal or regulatory requirements that mandate a driver's license

#### **Moving Forward:**

- If you have a pending workflow at your step when the questions go live, you will need to respond to the driver's license questions prior to submitting the workflow.
- Health L3s only you may need to return pending workflows at your step to the L2 submitters, so the new questions can be answered appropriately.
